NATIONAL VRIKSHAYURVEDA RESEARCH INSTITUTE, JHANSI

Medico-ethno-botanical survey tour was conducted in Maharaj Ganj forest division of Uttar Pradesh. The survey team collected 190 species. Some of the important plants collected from the area are Hemidesmus indicus (L.) R.Br. Piper longum L., Callicarpa macrophylla Vahl., Garuga pinnata Roxb., Celastrus paniculatus Willd., Barringtonia acutangula (L.) Gaertn., Strychnos nux-vomica L., Semecarpus anacardium Roxb.f., Stereospermum suaveolens DC. etc. Apart from this 11 folklore claims were collected. Total 98 coloured photographs of different plant species were taken. Authentication of Herbarium samples of M.Pharm. students of Bundelkhand University, Jhansi has been done by the survey section.

BACKGROUND AND MANDATE OF THE INSTITUTE

This Institute was established in the year 1963 with an objective to study the phytochemical activity of Medicinal Plants in and around the city of Chennai. Later Central Council for Research in Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy had taken over this Institute as a Grant-in-aid Unit. In the year 1978, the Institute became a part of Central Council for Research in Ayurveda and Siddha and now is under Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences, New Delhi. The activities of this institute are standardization of single drugs and compound formulations, phytochemical analysis, formulating Standard Operating Procedures and developing pharmacopoeial standards of medicines belonging to Ayurveda. Other activities are safety and toxicity studies of Ayurvedic drugs and antimicrobial studies. The Institute has departments of Pharmacognosy, Analytical Chemistry, Phytochemistry, Pharmacy, Microbiology, Pharmacology and Bio chemistry. This institute is recognized by Government of Tamil Nadu for testing Ayurveda and Siddha Drugs as DTL (Drug Testing laboratory). National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration of Laboratories (NABL) has accredited the Institute for chemical and biological scope.

The Institute is in receipt of **Eight Gold medals, six best paper awards** and **six cash awards** for their contribution to the field of Herbal Drug Research. As the Pioneer Institution in Standardization of Ayurvedic drugs it was awarded with Gold Medals by Gujarat Ayurved University.

This Institute has published 11 monographs so far and 440 research publications in various National and international journals. The Institute is affiliated with various Universities and 33 students have been awarded with Ph.D.

It has collaboration with many International and National Institutions viz. University of Glasgow, Scotland, UK; University college of Sciences, Kolkata and Institutions like ICMR, IGCAR, CEERI, CLRI and IIT Chennai.

As a mandatory requirement for recognition as Collaborative Institution for Traditional medicine by WHO, two projects sponsored by WHO have been completed by this institute.
